- Presentation text of the company

Since he started BMX and has become French champion and vice-champion of the World, Vincent Warin has developed an artistic research through the virtuous exploration of movements and the relationship that can exist between a man and a bike, between a man and a machine.

He helped bring BMX to art, dance, circus and theater. The creations he develops with Cie 3.6 / 3.4 are at the intersection of these disciplines: BMX, music and these new forms of circus and dance. The mixture of the practice of this sport exercised at a high level, confronted with an aesthetic and a poetic space are among the stakes of his artistic approach.

His singular and atypical universe is intended for a very wide audience.

In this acrobatic and solo BMX performance accompanied by live cello, Vincent Warin offers a surprising encounter. In turn facetious, domineering and caressing with his BMX, he plays all the constraints of mechanics ... It also transforms what we take first for a solo in a step of two sensual and energized. The litters, throws, imbalances on the wire are linked to the rhythm of the cries of the cello. Then the melody settles, electrifying the ballet offered by this well-matched couple. The human being is no more, the bike fades, and springs a new entity: L'Homme V.
